RESOLUTION NO. 2024-094

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE MUNICIPALITY OF CAINTA, RIZAL UNDER THE STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO THE DAMAGES CAUSED BY TYPHOON CARINA

WHEREAS, on the evening of July 23, 2024 up to July 24, 2024, torrential rain brought about by Tropical Storm Carina and intensified Southwest Monsoon, submerged most part of the municipality of Cainta causing huge damage to property and disruption of livelihood;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Atmospheric Geophysical and Astronomical Services or PAGASA issued Red Rainfall Warning in several areas in Luzon on July 24, 2024, which includes the province of Rizal;

WHEREAS, Red Rainfall Warning refers to torrential rain that may cause serious flooding, and life-threatening landslides in hazardous areas;

WHEREAS, the local government of Cainta recognizes the heavy burden brought by this natural calamity to affected victims, and shall provide immediate assistance the soonest possible time;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to declare the Municipality of Cainta under the State of Calamity due to the damages caused by Typhoon Carina.

Let copies of this resolution be furnished all concerned offices for their information, guidance and implementation.
